Work Study Scholarship Application

Application Deadline: March 1, 2018

Work study assignments are awarded to qualified individuals who may need help in meeting the expense of an ESSA workshop. Work study assignments vary. Some examples: help staff with Thursday Studio Stroll, librarian or clerical duties, housekeeping, grounds keeping, staffing special events, and other tasks that arise as needed. Upon completion of 30 hours of work, 5 days of workshop time will be provided to the student-employee. Workshop material fees and supplies are the responsibility of the individual.

ESSA considers individuals who are mature, team oriented, self-motivated and interested in the arts. Enthusiasm and commitment are required for these positions. All classes are based on availability. All work-study assignments will be based on an individual's strengths.

After the application deadline, which is March 1, a review committee meets to select which students are eligible to be interviewed for the available work study positions for the year. Our needs may vary from year to year as we grow.

After all interviews have been conducted, a final decision/placement will be made and you will be notified.
