

Small Metals Studio - Safety Requirements

Student should wear:

Closed toe shoes (shoes MUST provide full foot coverage)

Long hair pulled back

No loose/baggy clothing

Enamel Students: Respirator or Mask

Equipment Usage:

If a student needs a tool brought out from the metal cabinet, please ask instructor or studio coordinator to retrieve it.

*Always wear eye protection: safety glasses

*Wear ear protection when you or others are hammer forming on metal

*Use gloves to protect hands.

Torch Stations:

Do not adjust the acetylene setting on any tank. Instructor or coordinator only.

Please do not 'kink' or step on the acetylene hose. Please replace the torch tip in the cradle with the torch tip turned 'OFF' when not in use.

Disk Cutter, Rolling Mill & Hydraulic Press:

Disk Cutter, Mill and Hydraulic Press are ONLY to be used with the assistance of the instructor or coordinator.

Studio General

Clean up: Studio needs to be tidy at the end of each day. The final day of the class will be whole studio clean up requiring tool/material clean up and restock starting at 3:30.

All students/instructors/volunteers/coordinators are required to assist with clean up.

Tools available in studio:

Students are encouraged to bring their favorite tools for use.

The Small Metals Studio provides: Flexshafts, various files, hammers, saws, dapping blocks, buffing/polishing wheels.

The studio has some sheet metal, wire, and metal scrap available for purchase, inquire with the Studio Coordinator.
