

ESSA Ceramics Studio Details

Equipment Includes (but is not limited to):

Canvas-covered worktable and wedging boards

Plaster wedging table

Utility sink with clay trap

Large slab roller

Sculpture stands

Scales

Throwing wheels, batts and Giffin Grips

Three Kilns: larger kiln inner dimensions 22 x 20 inches, medium kiln inner dimensions 17 x 21 inches, smaller kiln inner dimensions 13 x 15 inches

Banding wheels

Shelves for works in progress, drying, etc.

Rolling pins

Various molds for draping/slumping

Numerous hand tools

Brushes and sponges both large and small

Various texturing sheets, small molds and stamps

Assorted commercial glazes (Amaco, Duncan, Stroke and Coat, and more)



The studio is located at the front of the ESSA campus and a 5-minute walk from on-campus housing and provides both indoor and covered outdoor work spaces.
