Firing Overview

Ceramic work is inherently variable, and ESSA cannot guarantee that any piece will survive the firing process. Tuition includes bisque and glaze firings completed during the workshop. Firing decisions will be made collaboratively with the instructor and studio coordinator(s).

Shipping & Transport

ESSA prefers not to ship fired work due to the high risk of damage. Shipping requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis and require a separate agreement. Please bring materials to safely transport your work home.

Participant Certification

By signing this agreement, you certify that:

- Any work from a previous class or work that was created outside of ESSA will not be fired.
- ESSA may decline to fire any piece that does not meet studio requirements.
- ESSA is not responsible for damage, failure, or loss during any stage of the firing process.
