Firing Overview

Ceramic work involves many variables, and ESSA cannot guarantee that any piece will survive the firing process. Tuition includes a bisque firing after the building portion of the workshop. Firing decisions will be made collaboratively with the instructor and studio coordinator(s).

Pick-Up & Timeline

ESSA will notify participants when firing is complete; no specific completion timeline is guaranteed. Pick-up must be arranged with the studio coordinator.

ESSA prefers not to ship fired work; shipping requests will be evaluated individually through a separate agreement.

Participant Certification

By signing this agreement, you certify that:

- Your pieces were made during your scheduled ESSA workshop and are clearly labeled. Any work from a previous class or work that was created outside of ESSA will **not** be fired.
- ESSA may decline to fire any piece that does not meet studio requirements.
- ESSA assumes no responsibility for loss or damage.
- Once notified, ESSA will hold your work for **no more than 30 days**. After 30 days, all unclaimed work and payments are forfeited.
- You are responsible for bringing materials to safely transport your work.
