



PEINE STUDIO INVENTORY

Note: Studio equipment is often shared between studios based on workshop needs. When preparing for a residency, please notify Studio Coordinator of all items needed, including those listed below. Please inquire with Studio Coordinator about what specific tools, supplies or equipment are needed. Your Studio Coordinator will do their best to place the needed supplies in the Peine Studio before your residency.

Dedicated Resources in Peine Studio:

- 2 large floor easels measuring 7 ½ feet tall, with canvas platforms of 4 feet wide
- Bathroom with hand washing sink attached, as well as a small sink with a sink trap in the studio. (Please do not put any chemicals down the drains. If you will need assistance with disposing of any chemicals, please inquire with your Studio Coordinator.)
- Various clamp lights with stands
- Scissors, palette knives, plastic containers- various sizes, rulers

Available Upon Request:

- Tabletop easels
- Self-healing cutting mats
- Various sizes of plastic and Masonite boards
- Extension cords, power strips
- Hair dryers, heat guns
- Glue guns (small amount of glue sticks)
- Plexiglass plates for ink or palettes, various sizes
- Sculpture stands for still life arrangements

Consumables:

- Rags, plastic palettes, masking tape, pens and pencils, sharpies, sketch paper, sponges, aprons, safety glasses, rulers

Should you find that you need specific supplies (i.e. q-tips, tissues, twine, cotton balls, table salt, etc.), please let your coordinator know and we will do our best to acquire them for you. ESSA has a myriad of 'one-off' art and craft supplies and may have what you need tucked away in a closet. Please don't hesitate to ask us, we are here to help.
