



Ceramics Studio - Safety Requirements

Studio General

Tie back long hair when using throwing wheels.

ESSA provides carving tools, hand tools, aprons, stamps, & glazes.

Students are encouraged to bring any favorite clay tools they might want to use from home.

Clean up: Studio needs to be tidy at the end of each day. At the end of each day, please clean off any tools used and sponge down canvas tables of any residual clay. The final day of the class will be whole studio clean up requiring tool/material clean up and restock starting at 3:30. Cleaning may require a respirator or N95 mask, studio coordinator will advise accordingly.

All students/instructors/volunteers/coordinators are required to assist with clean up.
