

Materials for Hands Online ESSA workshop with Julie Hop:

1. Watercolor paints, tubes are the best kind if you have them or a set of pans. For best results, look for or order the Prang brand.
2. Watercolor paper, buy Canson – available at Walmart or Hobby Lobby.
3. Small paintbrushes.
4. A hardboard or a sturdy piece of foam core – something you can tape your watercolor paper onto to keep it flat.
5. Painters or masking tape
6. Water container
7. Water spray bottle
8. Kleenex
9. #2 pencil
10. Good eraser, white rubber, or kneadable if you have one.
