

# Directions to make your CommUNITY Hope Flags

1. Cut pieces of fabric to 6" × 12". Use materials you already have on hand or you can pick up a free kit at 4 convenient locations
2. Flora Roja, the ESCC and ESSA will hang flag kits outside in front of their offices for pickup. Kits will also be available at Thursday Farmers Market.
3. Fold the top down on each piece of fabric and stitch in place to create a 3" sleeve, making the flag surface 6" × 9". If you don't sew, don't worry! You can use iron on hem adhesive or fabric glue!
4. Paint, stitch, applique, or collage the flags or use markers to decorate the flags with whatever images or words you desire to convey your message of hope and unity to the community.
5. Drop off your completed flag at the Thursday farmers market or at the ESCC (there will be a box outside to accept the completed flags) by October 29<sup>th</sup> at 10 am.
